



Safeguarding policy for junior events

Children and young people must be safe at every event. This policy sets out what we do and what we ask of adults.

1. Named safeguarding officer

Every tournament with junior players has a named safeguarding contact on site. Concerns can be raised with them in person, by phone or by email, in confidence.

2. Personal data of minors

We never publish the birth date or contact details of a player under 18. Players under 13 do not appear in public rankings, the player directory or search, and they are never tagged in photos.

3. Adults working with juniors

Coaches, officials and volunteers avoid being alone with a child, communicate through group channels that include parents, and never transport a child without a parent's consent.

4. Reporting a concern

If a child is in immediate danger call 112. Otherwise tell the safeguarding officer the same day; they record the concern and agree the next steps with the family.

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
